Gun Tests grade: D

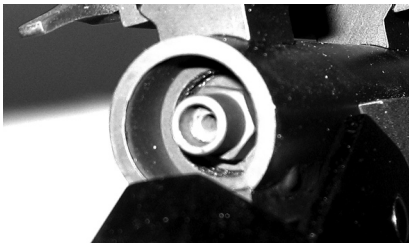
A heavy trigger, overall poor build quality, an unusable ramrod, a filthy breech area plagued by primer spittle, and reliability issues all combined to leave us sorely disappointed.

The Knight breech plug was comparatively filthy, allowing 209 primers to spit their material all over the inside of the breechplug area and action. The breechplug was positioned way too far inside the barrel.

Despite the use of high rings, the Knight Shadow had inadequate hammer to scope clearance to easily cock the gun, particularly with gloved hands.
