The PAP is a supposed step up from the WASR model, and in some ways, in clearly was — better stock finish, rubber buttpad, smoother metalwork, lock-open safety lever, pretty dang good trigger. We'd prefer a windage-adjustable rear sight.

**The receiver on the N-PAP is a stamped steel unit like most other AKs. The arrow points to the cutout in the safety lever that keeps the bolt open. That's a great feature for range safety, our testers said.**



**The handguards on the CIA are longer than a standard AK's. Also, better wood quality on them and the buttstock, below.**



**No, that's not the monolith from Kubrick's "2001" — it's a magazine headed for the single-stack-sized receiver hole. It's possible to have the port widened to accept standard AK mags.**
