Left: The M77 featured a three-position safety. Pulled fully to the rear, both the trigger and the bolt were locked into place. Right: The middle safety position locked down the trigger but allowed the bolt to move. Ruger describes this as the “Load/Unload” position. With the safety pushed fully forward, the rifle was ready to fire.

Ruger rings are available in different heights for both 1-inch and 30mm scopes. Simple to mount, they offer guaranteed alignment. Forward and rearward rings were not interchangeable. Shown in the foreground is Burris’s Ruger to Weaver adapter, (\$40, from brownells.com). Featuring all-steel construction, they are one of the few mounting options available for Ruger rifles.
